On the occasion of their 90th anniversary, the Garden Club of Bermuda held a Garden Celebration at Palm Grove on Saturday, May 14th.

Palm Grove was built by the Honourable Edmund and Winifred Gibbons and is now the home of grandson James, and Judy Gibbons – 20 acres sweep down from South Road Devonshire to the sea – the gardens are a contrast between manicured beauty and wild natural terrain, where many endangered species can be found. Most famous for the nineteen meter pool with the turf map of Bermuda, there is also an aviary and orchard and vegetable garden as well as a nursery.

The house was designed by renowned Bermuda architect Will Onions for entertaining, especially musical evenings, and there is a wonderful collection of contemporary art and a gallery of black and white photographs. The Gibbons were on hand to welcome guests on the day and give tours of the house and gardens. A history of the house is featured in the Bermuda National Trust's Historic Buildings project - 'Devonshire-Vol !'
