The Garden Club of Bermuda has announced four new recipients for its 2015 scholarship. They are Kidane Callender, Hutson Carter II, Jayson Jackson and Anna Terceira. Three of the awardees, Mr. Callender, Mr. Carter II and Ms. Terceira were previous winners.
